Minutes of Meeting May 9, 2017

Meeting Called To Order at: 7:00 p.m.

Adoption of minutes of meeting of April 11, 2017

Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer reported to those in attendance.

Old Business

- Blake Tibbetts said he had been to the range and found steel pistol targets placed on the floor of the shooting bay rather than the elevated area for target stands. Targets placed on the ground like this increase the risk of ricochets and projectiles skipping over the berms.
- Dave Greene repeated the warning that the 25/50 yard shooting line and the pistol bay are not approved for birdshot. Shot can only be used for aerial targets on the shotgun range or while using the manual thrower on the 100 yard line.
- Dave Greene said there were still spots open on the Winchester shotgun shoot but the Beretta and Browning shoots are full. Contact Dave if you wish to attend.
- Dave Greene asked for more volunteers to come forward so the Scout appreciation day can take place at the range this September. He once again circulated a list of tasks that need members to take ownership.
- Blake Tibbetts said there were 11 members who attended the IPSC Black Badge course. Contact Blake or Jody Waring if you wish to attend the next course.

New Business

- Blake Tibbetts scheduled Saturday May 27th as range clean up day. There are many tasks that need to be completed to prepare our range for another season of use. We will begin at 9:00 am and ask any available members to please assist your club. Any time you can spare is greatly appreciated.
- Blake Tibbetts said comprehensive first aid kits have been purchased and placed in the seacans. Please ensure they are used responsibly and advise the executive if any items are used so they can be replaced.
- Dave Greene said we have received our certificate of affiliation from the RNBRA.
- Dave Greene said he had once again found .22 caliber misfires littering the ground at the 25/50 yard firing point. Pick them up and put them in the misfires box. Also both Dave and Blake Tibbetts have found numerous centerfire brass discarded on the range. Pick them up, most rifle brass is over a dollar a piece.
- Dave Greene asked again that paper trash be put in the burn barrels & plastic jugs, etc. be taken home by who ever brought them out.
- Dave Greene had obtained a quote for materials to run power out to the new 25/50 yard seacan from the shotgun seacan. Dave made a motion to purchase the materials when funds are available, seconded by Dave Anderson. The motion carried unanimously.
